The seats are limited and admission will be done strictly on merit basis.

- 3 Students from Mumbai University B.A. with Economics (Minimum 3 papers of 300 Marks) and other than Mumbai University B.A. with Economics (Minimum 3 papers of 300 Marks) at their 5th and 6th Semester are eligible to apply for the course. For other than Arts faculty and subjects other than Economics students have to appear for a **Change of Faculty/Change of Subject Test** (date to be announced later) which will be conducted by the Department. The eligibility criteria for **Change of Faculty/Change of Subject Test** applicants will be the same as above. The change of Faculty/change of subject test will be held in MCQ format (online mode) and cover logical reasoning and TYBA level Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Maths and Statistics.

- 4 Backward class candidates should be domicile of Maharashtra State and should belong to the categories notified by the Maharashtra State viz. (a) Scheduled Castes (including SC category persons who have adopted Baudha Religion) (b) Scheduled Tribes (c) VJ/NT, Special Backward Class and (d) Other Backward Class etc.
- 5 Seats will be reserved as per Government and University rules, which may be amended from time to time. A copy of the relevant certificates must accompany applications of all categories of students belonging to reserved categories.
- 6 Separate merit lists will be prepared for general and reserved category students as per relevant government rules. For students with a double major only marks of the Economics papers across 5th and 6th Semesters will be considered for the merit list.
- 7 All the necessary documents (including Caste Certificate and All Semester Grade cards) wherever applicable should be submitted along with the application form. Economics Graduates from any other recognized University will be given admission subject to obtaining provisional eligibility certificate from University of Mumbai after their name appear in the merit list.
- 8 All the completed application forms should reach the Office of the MSE-PP within 10 days from the date of declaration of Mumbai University B.A. results of the Sept./Oct. 2020 examinations (academic year 2019-2020).

Forms must be sent by post/ Courier to 'The Director, Mumbai School of Economics & Public Policy (Autonomous), University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Santacruz (E), Mumbai 400098 along with necessary documents.

Students should track their applications by email/phone call whether it has reached at the Department. (see point 12)
