PREAMBLE

Rules of the Competition

1. Name of the Competition Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter Collegiate Elocution Competitions in English.
2. The Competition will be open to all Students, both Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate of all colleges affiliated to University of Mumbai.
3. There will be five topics for the competition and any one of them will be given to a participant half an hour before actual commencement of the competition.
4. Order of the participants will be arranged alphabetically.
5. Procedure for selecting students for the competition will be as follows:
 - a. only one student from each college affiliated to the University, will be allowed to participate .
 - b. It will select one winner from amongst those participants in the competition and nominate him/her for the final round to be organized at the University of Pune.
 - c. Every participant will be given 5 (five) minutes. A warning bell will be given after 4 (four) minutes.
6. All expenses such as travel, lodging, boarding etc. of the participant at the university round will have to be borne by the respective colleges.
7. Decision of the Panel of Judges will be final and binding.
