**C I R C U L A R**

NO. Elg./C/ 1652 of 2014.

In continuation of this office circular No. Elg./C/5411 of 2009, dated 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2009, the Director / Principals of the constituent affiliated Colleges / Heads of the Departments / recognized Institutions and the Director, Institute of Distance Education are hereby informed that the Academic Council at it's meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2013 vide item No.01 and Management Council's meeting on 07/07/2014 vide item No. 24 in the matter of accepting the change of terminology of the I.B. Certificate changed to IB Courses. According to the letter dated 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2013 from the IB, "Successful IB Diploma candidates receive an IB diploma and the transcript with Diploma Results stating "Diploma Awarded". In order to receive the IB diploma, students must complete examinations in six subject areas (at least 3 and not more than 4 subjects are taken at higher level) and successfully complete the core requirements including an Extended Essay (EE), Creativity Action Service (CAS) and Theory of Knowledge (TOK). An IB diploma candidate who fails to satisfy the requirements for the award of an IB diploma will receive Diploma Programme Results and a transcript stating "Diploma Programme Courses awarded"

It was resolved that all students registered for the full IB Diploma with core requirements (Theory of Knowledge, Extended Essay and Creativity, Action and Service) and minimum of 24 points, and the best five subjects considering for determining eligibility for Arts/Commers/Science and Law courses. The Academic Council after consideration resolved as under:-

**"Resolved that the Circular be sent to all affiliated colleges /University Departments regarding the IB policy and the best five subjects considering for determining eligibility for Arts, Commers, Science and Law courses.**

The various levels of subjects in International Baccalureate (I.B.) are as under:-

“I.B. Diploma with Physics and Maths at Higher Level and Chemistry at Standard Level (3 HL and 3 SL) be made eligible for Bachelor of Engineering (except Chemical Engineering) and Maths, Chemistry at Higher Level (HL) and Physics at Standard Level (SL) ( 3 HL and 3 SL) be made eligible for Bachelor of Chemical Engineering courses. As regards to the B. Pharm Course ( 3 HL and 3 SL) , it was Resolved that the I.B. Diploma with Chemistry, Maths at HL and Physics/Biology at SL be made eligible for B.Pharm. and I.B. Diploma with Mathematics (HL) be made eligible for B. Arch Course”.

It was further Resolved that I.B. D. P. students (3 HL & 3 SL) holder be made eligible for various courses under the faculty of Arts/Commerce/Science and Law. It was also Resolved that the best five subjects (full pass i.e. 35/100 for each subject) are considering for determining eligibility for Arts/Commerce/Science and Law courses.
