CIRCULAR :-

The Principals of affiliated colleges in Commerce, imparting instruction in the examination held in First Half of the year 2015, on behalf of the University are hereby informed that the representations received from Prin. R. J. College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Ghatkopar, regarding the question paper in the subject of Financial Accounting & Auditing at T.Y.B.Com. examination held on 21/04/2015, was referred to the concerned Dean, Faculty of Commerce for his opinion.

In reply, the concerned Dean, Faculty of Commerce has suggested as under :-

"...1) To protect the interest of students who were compulsorily given question papers of 60 Marks (Instead of 100 Marks), the following decision may be taken.

Considering the fact that syllabus of the courses F A A of 60 marks and 100 marks categories were the same, Marks secured by the candidates who appeared for the examination out of 60 Marks be proportionately increased to out of 100 Marks and result of the students be declared accordingly.

The above suggestions have been accepted by the Vice-Chancellor.

In view of the above suggestions, made by the concerned paper-setter, the concerned examiners and moderators are hereby requested to take immediate action accordingly.
