The Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) of the National University of Singapore is inviting applications from Public sector officials for its 2008 Master in Public Policy (MPP) and Master in Public Administration (MPA) programmes. The two-year MPP and the one-year MPA begin in July 2008.

The MPP provides a foundation in conceptual and analytical skill for future public service leaders and individuals with an interest in understanding and influencing how public policy choices are made. The MPA provides an intensive, interdisciplinary course of study for experienced professionals who wish to acquire new knowledge and skills to enhance their leadership and managerial capabilities.

The LKYSPP is an autonomous graduate school of the National University of Singapore (NUS). The school inherited NUS' public policy programme which was developed in partnership with Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government. LKYSPP continues to maintain the partnership with Harvard and the Kennedy School. LKYSPP formally became the first institution outside Europe and North America to join the prestigious Global Public Policy Network (GPPN) in 2007. GPPN is an alliance of globally reputable institutions comprising the London School of Economics (LSE), the Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris (Sciences Po) and Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA).
