The Principal of the constituent Colleges in Arts, Commerce and Science and the co-ordinator / Assistant Registrar. Ratnagiri Sub Centre are hereby informed that the centralized admission and schedule for admission procedure for the M.Sc. Degree course in the subject of 1) Organic Chemistry 2) Inorganic Chemistry 3) Analytical Chemistry 4) Physical Chemistry will be as under:-

1. The Centralized admission Process (CAP) for the subject of Chemistry will be for all the students of the University of Mumbai. Circular in this respect will be issued immediately.
2. The colleges will collect the application forms on payment for application fees for admission to M.Sc. Chemistry from either PG / Account Section, Mumbai (Zone-I), C.K.T. College, New Panvel, Raigad (Zone II) and from Gogate Joglekar College Ratnagiri (Ratnagiri and Sindhurga Zone-III) .
3. There will be Three zones for the Centralized Admission Process.
Zone I -Colleges in Mumbai and Thane, (form submission and counseling centre, PG section, University of Mumbai, Fort , Mumbai-400 032)
Zone II -Colleges in Raigad, (form submission and counseling centre, C.K.T. College, Khanda Colony, New Panvel)

Zone III -Ratnagiri and Sindhurga. (form submission and counseling centre, Gogate Joglekar College, Ratnagiri)

Zone II / III Colleges (List of Colleges)

The students will submit application forms through respective zonal centers. 1) For Mumbai University Students:

- a) The students who have been declared in First Class and above without grace marks with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600.
- b) The students who have been declared passed in First Class with grace marks/Second class with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600
- c) The students offering two major subjects, Chemistry as one of the subject at T.Y.Sc be admitted in order of merit by considering marks secured in Chemistry at TY.B.Sc only.
- d) In case there is a tie in a). b) or c) then aggregate marks without grace marks out of 800.
- e) In case there is a tie in a), b),c) or d) then marks in theory out of 400 without grace marks
