CIRCULAR :

The Principals of the constituent Colleges in Arts, Commerce and Science and the co-ordinator/Asistant Registrar, Ratnagiri Sub Centre are hereby informed that the centralized admissions and schedule for admission procedure for the M. Sc. Degree course in the subject of 1) Organic Chemistry 2) Inorganic Chemistry 3) Analytical Chemistry 4) Physical Chemistry will be as under :-

1. The Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for the subject of Chemistry will be for all the students of the University of Mumbai. Circular in this respect will be issued immediately.

The colleges will collect the application forms on payment for application fees for admission to M.Sc. Chemistry from either Ratnagiri Sub Centre or Account Section, Fort, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai- 400 032.

There will be two zones for the Centralized Admission Process, zone I & zone II.

The Colleges Mahad onwards & towards Sawantwadi will form the cluster of Colleges called **Zone I**.

The other rest of the colleges will form **Zone II**.

Zone I – Colleges (List of Colleges)

The students will submit application forms through respective Colleges. After collecting application forms from students, Colleges/institutions will forwards applications to the Ratnagiri Sub Centre. There will be One common merit list for all the students offering Chemistry. Common merit list will be displayed on the website of the University and also list will be display on the Notice Board of the Post-Graduate Section, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai- 400 032. Merit list will also be mailed to the Colleges provided mail address is communicated to the University.

2. The merit list will be prepared as follows :-

I] For Mumbai University Students :

- a) The students who have been declared in First Class and above without grace marks with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600.
- b) The students who have been declared passed in First Class with grace marks / Second Class with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600.
- c) The students offering two major subjects, Chemistry as one of the subject at T.Y.B.Sc. be admitted in order of merit by considering marks secured in Chemistry at T.Y.B.Sc. only.
- d) In case there is a tie in a), b) or c) then aggregate marks without grace marks out of 800.
- e) In case there is a tie in a), b), c) or d) then marks in theory out of 400 without grace marks

II] For other University Students :

Marks declared by the concerned University at T.Y.B.Sc. Examination and as shown in mark sheet in the subject of Chemistry will be considered for preparing the merit list as per quota available for other University students.
