**CIRCULAR :**

Attention of the Directors/Heads of University Departments/Centres, Principal of Sir J.J. College of Architecture, Librarian, University Library and Principals of the affiliated colleges (including minority aided and unaided) is invited to the University Circular No. च.म. /188/2003 dated 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2003 and च.म. /189/2003 dated 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2003 under which various Government Resolutions dated 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2003 regarding procedure of admission, reservation in minority/non minority, aided/unaided Educational Institutions, management quota and preparation of merit list etc were circulated for implementation. Their attention is also invited to the judgement given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of T.M.A. Pai foundation and others v/s State of Karnataka and others (Writ Petition No. 317/1993) and further judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Islamic Academy of Education and others v/s State of Karnataka (Petition No. 305/1993) and also the judgement given by the Hon'ble High Court, Bombay in various petitions on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2003. It has been observed that inspite of the above judgements of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and High Court, Bombay, Government Resolutions and University Circulars, some minority educational institutions have not implemented the reservation policy. Their attention is also invited to University Circular No. Aff./Recog./211 of 2004 dated 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2004 under which necessary instructions have been issued to all concerned. As regards to management quota, it is clarified that management quota may be first deducted from the intake capacity and remaining seats shall be filled up as under :-

Example :- Minority :-

Intake capacity	100 seats
15% Management Quota	15 seats
Balance	-----
50% Minority (First In - house then outsiders if seats available)	85 seats
50% open and reserved	43 seats
21 seats open + 21 seats reserved category (first In-house then outsiders if seats available)	42 seats

P.T.C.

Example :- Non - Minority :-

Intake capacity	100 seats
15% Management Quota	- 15 seats

Balance	85 seats
50% open (first In - house then outsiders if seats available)	43 seats
50% reserved (first In - house then outsiders if seats available) (SC/ST/DT/NT/OBC)	42 seats

A Committee consisting of Principal Dr. R.A. Heredia (Convener), Principal Dr. V.N. Magare and Principal Dr. P.M. Sule has been constituted to monitor the admissions. The Deputy Registrar, Affiliation and Deputy Registrar, Special Cell shall be assisting the committee.

The Committee shall monitor the admission and collect the information from the colleges regularly in the prescribed format and submit the reports to the Vice - Chancellor.

They are further requested to implement the reservation policy and fill up the seats as per the above example and submit report in the enclosed proforma alongwith the merit lists.

The Principals are hereby requested to adhere by the admission norms laid down by the University.
