CIRCULAR :-

Subject: Formation of Advisory Committee to look into the matter relating to reservation as well as other Education Programme for SC/ST

Heads/Directors of the University Departments / Centres and Principals, of the Non-Government Colleges are hereby informed that as suggested by the University Grants Commission, an Advisory Committee under the Chairmanship of the Head/Director/Principal be set up/form in the Departments/Centres/Colleges. The Committee should meet at least once in a quarter and more frequently according to the need. There is a need for this committee to meet after the admission process is completed but before the admission is closed to take stock of the fulfillment of the reservation and to take corrective steps in time before of the University/College who belong to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes who have been taking interest in the educational reservation and educational progress of the SC/ST and members of the teaching staff who while not belonging to SC/ST, have also been taking interest in the welfare of the backward classes.


They are further requested to send a report about the fulfillment of reservation for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes to the University within a week of the completion of the admission process but not before closing admission so that in case any corrective steps are required to be taken for the current year it may not be too late.

The University after receiving the report from the Departments/Centre/Colleges will send a complete comprehensive report of admission of SC/ST fulfillment of reservation in all Courses/Faculties/Departments incorporating and analyzing the reports received from them to the University Grants Commission and a copy to the Special Commissioner for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes within days of the completion of the admission process but not before admission is closed to facilitate timely remedial measures, if necessary in the concerned academic year itself.


They are further requested to communicate to the University the action taken in this behalf.
