## **CIRCULAR:-**

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Five Year Integrated (B.A. and M.A.) degree course in German <u>vide</u> this office Circular No.UG/270 of 2006, dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2006 and the Head, University Department of German, the Principals of the affiliated Colleges in Arts are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Arts at its meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2012 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 <u>vide</u> item No. 4.102 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2013, 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2013 & 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2013 <u>vide</u> item No. 13 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, the Ordinance 5610 relating to the eligibility criteria for Five years Integrated degree course in B.A.& M.A. in German Studies is amended, which is available on the University's web site (<u>www.mu.ac.in</u>) and that the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2013–2014 which is read as under:-

**The amended <u>O.5610</u>:** Eligibility Criteria for the First Year of the B.A. in German Studies be read as under: -

The student opting for the five year integrated course in German Studies must have:

Passed with 45% in HSC or any other equivalent exam having chosen German as a Foreign Language in the XII standard, OR

Passed with 45% in HSC and cleared the Diploma course in German offered by the University of Mumbai, or any other India University OR

Passed with 45% in HSC and cleared Grundstufe III offered by Goethe Institute (Max Mueller Bhavan) and

Eligibility Criteria for the Second Year of the B.A. in German Studies

F.Y.B.A. of the B.A. in German Studies offered by the University of Mumbai, or any other University, recognized by the University of Mumbai. OR First Year of the Bachelors' Programmes of the University of Mumbai in any discipline, or any other University, recognized by the University of Mumbai

+ Passed A2 level of the Goethe Institute/MMB or

Passed Diploma in German of the University of Mumbai, or any other University, recognized by the University of Mumbai or

having equivalent German language competence

+ Passed the written and oral Entrance Test of the Department of German, University of Mumbai

Calculation of credits: For candidates joining B.A. in German at the S.Y.B.A. level, 30 credits shall be assigned for the First Year and their First Year marks/Grades shall be calculated / converted into Grades (letter grade and grade point) according to the existing Marks-Grades conversion scale being followed by the University of Mumbai at the Department and be sent to the Exam House.
