MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI

AND

EDITH COWAN UNIVERSITY

(the 'Parties')

WHEREAS University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai, 400032 a public university established in 1857 including departments and affiliated colleges is engaged in the education and training of undergraduate and postgraduate students; and

WHEREAS Edith Cowan University, 270 Joondalup Drive, Joondalup WA 6027, Australia, a public university established pursuant to the *Edith Cowan University Act 1984*, wishes to develop its relationships with respected education and training institutions; and

WHEREAS The Parties recognise that collaborative efforts will be of mutual benefit and may contribute to an enduring institutional linkage for education co-operation and assistance,

NOW, THEREFORE The Parties agree to continue discussions as opportunities arise to ascertain how co-operative activities could be implemented in the future. These activities could include:

1. *The development of programs and services in specific areas of mutual interest including online teaching and cross institutional study.*
2. *The provision of formal award courses and professional development courses in Information Technology, Engineering, Security, Contemporary Arts and Environmental Management , as mutually agreed by the Parties;*
3. *The development of collaborative research projects; and*
4. *Staff and student visits.*

This Memorandum of Understanding will commence on the date shown below and operate for a period of three years.


Should specific joint activities arise as a result of further discussions, details will be set forth in an Agreement, to be signed at the appropriate time by the authorised representatives of the Parties.
