1. Admissions are strictly on merit (written test / personal interview).
2. Admissions of SC/ST/DT/NT/OBC/SBC are as per rules.
3. A Hard Copy of application must be complete in all respects and must be submitted to the Head, Department of Sociology, University of Mumbai before the Entrance Test. Application received thereafter will not be entertained.
4. Application must be accompanied by copies of the statement of marks obtained by the applicants at the Bachelor's and Master's degree examinations, Certified by the Principal of the constituent college/the Head of a recognized institutions/member of the Senate of this University or a Magistrate along with original which will be returned on verification.
5. Applicant who have obtained Master's Degree from a University other than University of Mumbai are required to obtain a certificate of eligibility (Provisional) from the University Office (Eligibility Section, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Bhavan, Ground Floor, Vidyanagari Campus, Kalina, Santacruz (East), Mumbai – 400 098 (if selected) before they can be admitted to the M.Phil Course at the University Department of Sociology.
6. No Student will be allowed to appear for an examination unless he has attended in each term the prescribed lectures/ symposium/seminars/workshop etc. if any, conducted in the subject as per rules.

IMPORTANT:

7. A letter from the Principal of the college where candidate is employed at present stating:
 - a) Date of substantive appointment in the Senior/Junior College.
 - b) Date and number of the communication of the University regarding the approval after the selection procedure.
 - c) Nature of the post full-time/part-time.
