Second Entrance Test for Admission to M.A. (Credit-based) in Economics 2023-2024

- Students will be admitted to the M.A. (Credit-based) Full time regular programme through an offline entrance examination only. All the students from UGC recognised Universities and AICTE approved institutions are eligible to apply for the course. Second Entrance Examination for the Academic Year 2023-24, will be held on Thursday 31st August, 2023 from 10.30 a.m to 01.30 p.m. through ONLINE MODE. Students in the last year of their graduation can also apply for the Entrance Test; however, their final admission to the course would depend upon their having obtained the required marks at the graduation examination.
- 2. The Entrance Test will also serve as change-of-faculty/change of subject test provided the minimum requirements are fulfilled. Minimum passing marks for change-of-faculty/change of subject test are 40.
- 3. Reserved Categories candidates should be domicile of Maharashtra State and should belong to the categories notified by the Maharashtra State viz (a) Scheduled castes (including SC category persons who have adopted Baudha Religion) (b) Scheduled Tribes (c) VJ/NT, Special Backward Class and (e) Other Backward Class etc. Valid non-creamy layer certificate must be attached for OBC those categories which are required to submit it to claim reservation quota as per Govt. rules.
- 4. There will be an examination fee (non-refundable) of Rs. 150/- (for students belonging to reserved categories <u>examination fee of Rs.50/-</u>), in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of <u>Finance & Accounts Officer, University of Mumbai</u>', payable at <u>Mumbai</u> to be posted to 'The Director, Mumbai School of Economics & Public Policy (Autonomous),3rd Floor, Ranade Bhavan, <u>University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Santacruz (E), Mumbai 400098</u>, or they may submit the same in the MSE-PP office in person on or before 30th August, 2023.
- 5. Link for Online Examination will be sent on the registered email id of the candidates. In case one does not receive the same because of any reason it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to contact the MSE-PP for the same.
- 6. Candidates will have to make their own arrangement for functional device, Internet Connection, Electricity etc. so as to appear for the online exam.
- 7. The dates for holding the Entrance Test, the broad scope of the examination, application form and details of the M.A. Economics regular course are available on the University of Mumbai website.

- 8. Students from outside the University of Mumbai will be admitted subject to their obtaining a provisional eligibility certificate from the Eligibility Section of the University of Mumbai for the M.A. [Economics] course after the declaration of ET results.

- 10. Separate merit lists will be prepared for general and reserved category students as per relevant government rules. Though a category-wise merit list of all examinees will be computed, successive lists will be put up to fill in remaining vacancies.
- 11. For the purpose of preparing the merit lists, the performance of the University of MumbaiEconomics students (with at least three papers in Economics of 100 marks at graduation /Finalyear) will be computed by giving 50% weightage to their graduation marks and 50% weightage to the marks obtained at the Entrance Test. The performance of all other students will be computed on the basis of 100% weightage to the Entrance Test marks.
- 12. There will be 2 papers of 50 marks each.

Before the examination a list of students along with their names and Google Meet link will be sent on email id. Those who cannot find their names in the list must contact the MSE-PP for the same.
