PREAMBLE

Rules of the Competition

- 1. Name of the Competition Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter Collegiate Elocution Competitions in English.
- 2. The Competition will be open to all Students, both Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate of all colleges affiliated to University of Mumbai.
- 3. There will be five topics for the competition and any one of them will be given to a participant half an hour before actual commencement of the competition.
- 4. Order of the participants will be arranged alphabetically.
- 5. Procedure for selecting students for the competition will be as follows:
 - a. only one student from each college affiliated to the University, will be allowed to participate .
 - b. It will select one winner from amongst those participants in the competition and nominate him/her for the final round to be organized at the University of Pune.
 - c. Every participant will be given 5 (five) minutes. A warning bell will be given after 4 (four) minutes.
