2. Eligibility Case :-

The students, who have passed their qualifying examination from other than Maharashtra State HSC Board and from Universities other than University of Mumbai, fall under Eligibility Cases. Such students are requested to obtain Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Assistant Registrar, Eligibility Section, Room No. 108A, First Floor, University of Mumbai, Institute of Distance and Open Learning, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma Bhavan, Vidyanagari, Santacruz (East), Mumbai-400 098, before the admission Application for Provisional Statement of Eligibility will be available from the commencement date of admission till last date of admission only). The student should submit the attested Xerox copies of all the certificates including all years failed/ATKT marksheets and should produce all the original certificates while submitting the application for Provisional Statement of Eligibility. They should bring their all original certificates/documents with them. They can also take the printout of Eligibility Form available on website www.mu.ac.in link as Eligibility and Enrolment.
