Admission to the M.Sc. degree Course (By Papers) 2013-14

The Principals of the affiliated/constituent Colleges in Arts, Commerce & Science and the Coordinator / Assistant Registrar, University Sub Center, Ratnagiri are hereby notified that-

1. The **University Departments** for all Science subjects (**including Chemistry**) will complete the admission procedure of M.Sc. to the students on merit by following the reservation norms as described by University from time to time, **on or before 25th June, 2013.**
2. All the **Colleges** which have the courses for **M.Sc. on unaided basis (including Chemistry) except Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Geology and Biochemistry** will complete the admission procedure to the students on merit by following the reservation norms as described by University of Mumbai from time to time, **on or before 25th June, 2013.**
3. Admissions to the M.Sc. Degree course in the **subjects of Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Geology and Biochemistry** for the Academic Year 2013 – 2014:

The students should collect and submit the admission forms for the M.Sc. degree course in the subjects of Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Geology and Biochemistry, **on or before 25th June, 2013.**

Copies of the prescribed application forms for admission to the course can be obtained from the Finance & Accounts Office, Ground floor, Room No. 13, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032, on payment of Rs.100/- (in cash), from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm and 1.30 pm to 2.30 pm on week days except Second and Fourth Saturdays.

4. The **Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP)** for the M.Sc. Degree course on **Aided basis** in the subjects of **1) Organic Chemistry 2) Inorganic Chemistry 3) Analytical Chemistry 4) Physical Chemistry** will be as under :-
 - A) All colleges having **UN-AIDED M.Sc. Chemistry** programme will give admission by following reservation norms declared by University of Mumbai from time to time, and will declare their own schedule of admissions but all admissions should be completed **on or before 25th June, 2013.**

They shall forward list of admitted students and vacant seats to Post Graduate Studies Section, University of Mumbai *immediately*, before the CAP starts.

B) The Centralized Admissions Process (CAP) for M.Sc. in the subject of **Chemistry** for **Aided stream** for the students of the University of Mumbai is as follows :

- a) The students can collect the application forms on payment, for admission to M.Sc. Chemistry for Aided stream from either University sub Centre, Ratnagiri ,or Account Section, Room No. 13, Ground Flour , University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032.
- b) The students will submit application forms either through respective colleges or to the Post Graduate Studies Section, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032. After collecting application forms from students, the Colleges / Institutions will forward applications to the PG Section, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032. **The last date for receiving the applications through colleges will be 25th June, 2013.**
- c) The colleges should submit the applications to University within the specified date, else students will forfeit his/her claim of admission through merit list in aided section. An advance intimation through e-mail should be forwarded to the following addresses-

There will be one common merit list for all the students offering Chemistry. Common merit list for all the colleges offering aided course in Chemistry will be displayed on the website of the University and also on the Notice Board of the Post Graduate Studies Section, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032. Merit list will also be mailed to the Colleges provided; mail address is communicated to the University.

1. The criteria taken into consideration for merit list will be as follows :-

I. **For Mumbai University Students :**

- a) The students who have been declared in First Class and above without grace marks with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600.
- b) The students who have been declared passed in First Class with grace marks / Second Class with Chemistry as a single major subject out of 600.

- c) The students offering two major subjects, Chemistry as one of the subject at T.Y.B.Sc. be admitted in order of merit by considering marks secured in Chemistry at T.Y.B.Sc. only.
- d) In case there is a tie in a), b) or c) aggregate marks without grace marks out of 800.
- e) In case there is a tie in a), b), c) or d) then marks in theory out of 400 without grace marks.

II. For other University Students :

Marks declared by the concerned University at T.Y.B.Sc. Examination and as shown in mark sheet in the subject of Chemistry will be considered for preparing the merit list as per quota available for other University students.
