O 6135 **Title:** B.B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) (5 Years Integrated)

O 6136 **Eligibility Criteria** - The admission to 1st Semester of B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) shall be open to any candidate who has obtained a in Higher Secondary School/Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent certificate from a recognized Board with not less than 45% marks in aggregate (40% in case of reserved category candidates) and should be below 20 years of age as on 1st July 2014 (22 years in case of reserved category candidates and Persons with Disability (PWD).

R 8774 **Intake capacity:** 60 (per division)

R 8775 **Fee Structure:** Rs. 50,000/- per year

R 8776 **Duration:** The duration of the degree is divided in to five years and each year is divided in to two semesters.

Note – Standard of passing and Teachers Qualification will be as per University rules and regulations.
