You may be aware that the University Grants Commission has been implementing the **Innovative Programme - Teaching and Research in Interdisciplinary and Emerging Areas** to (a) support specialized courses at UG and PG levels including one year PG Diploma after PG in Interdisciplinary and Emerging Areas and (b) accommodate brilliant ideas and innovative proposals to influence teaching, research, academic excellence, societal growth and relevant activities in various disciplines which meet educational, national and global priorities.

Since the XII Plan guidelines of Innovative Programme are under revision, the UGC has decided to consider fresh proposals for the year 2012-13 as per XI Plan guidelines. The Guidelines of XI Plan Innovative Programme are available in the UGC website (www.ugc.ac.in).

It has been decided to invite fresh proposals, prescribed for XI plan within the ceiling and as per the prescribed format given in the guidelines, from University departments and colleges affiliated to your university which are eligible to receive UGC assistance under section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. You are, therefore, requested to download the guidelines and circulate it to your university departments and colleges affiliated to your university.

It may be noted that proposal(s) should be duly filled in and signed by the competent authority in the university. All colleges including autonomous colleges should route the proposal through the respective affiliated university. It may kindly be noted that the proposals falling under the categories as mentioned in the guidelines at S. No. 5 (i to vii) and 6 at page no. 6 & 7 will also NOT be considered.

The university/institute and colleges are requested to submit only two/one proposal respectively. If the university/institute and colleges submits more than the stipulated number of proposals, none of them will be considered.

The university / college if not having PG Departments may not apply for PG Diploma Courses.

The Departments of the university and the colleges who are interested in applying under the scheme may be requested to read of the Guidelines carefully before sending them.

The last date for receipt of the proposal in the UGC Office, New Delhi under the above programme is 31st July, 2012. The proposals received after this date and without prescribed format will not be entertained by the UGC.

Three copies of the proposals as per Guidelines through proper channel for induction under the above programme may be sent to the undersigned for consideration of the Commission.
